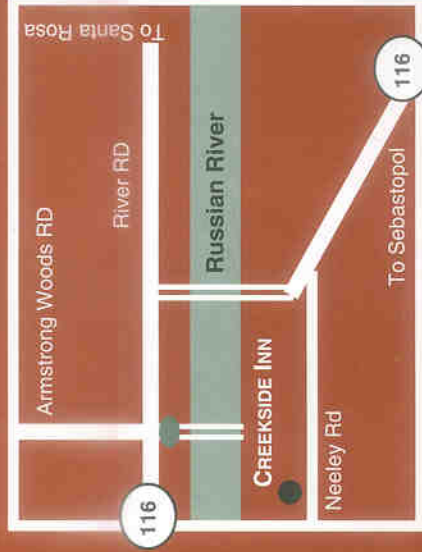

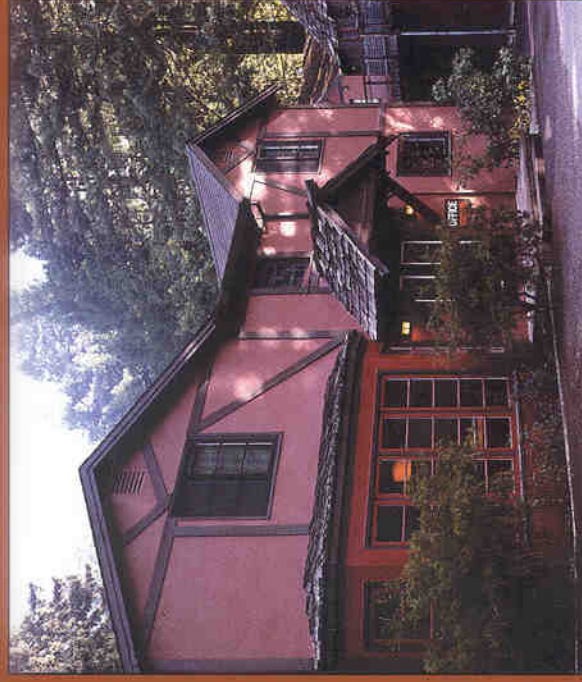

## General Policies

- Well-behaved guests of all ages and orientations are welcome but absolutely NO pets are allowed on the premises without prior approval.
- Rates do not include tax and, unless guaranteed by reservation, may be changed without notice.
- Inn guests are served a full breakfast each morning. Since they enjoy use of their own kitchens, guests in the cottages do not join us for breakfast.
- All rooms and cottages have phones with voice mail and free local calls. The number to reach guests is 707.869.1364 followed by the room extension.
- Check out time is 11 AM. Guests are checked in from 3-6 PM. Exceptions are available but are charged over and above the regular room rate.
- Seven days notice of cancellation is required for refund of deposits or pre-paid reservations. A \$15 cancellation fee will be charged.
- Minimum stay requirements for reservations:
  - 2 night minimum on weekends
  - 3 to 4 night minimums for holidays
  - One week minimum in cottages during the months of July and AugustShorter stays may be permitted if arranged in advance but a \$10-\$50 per night premium applies.

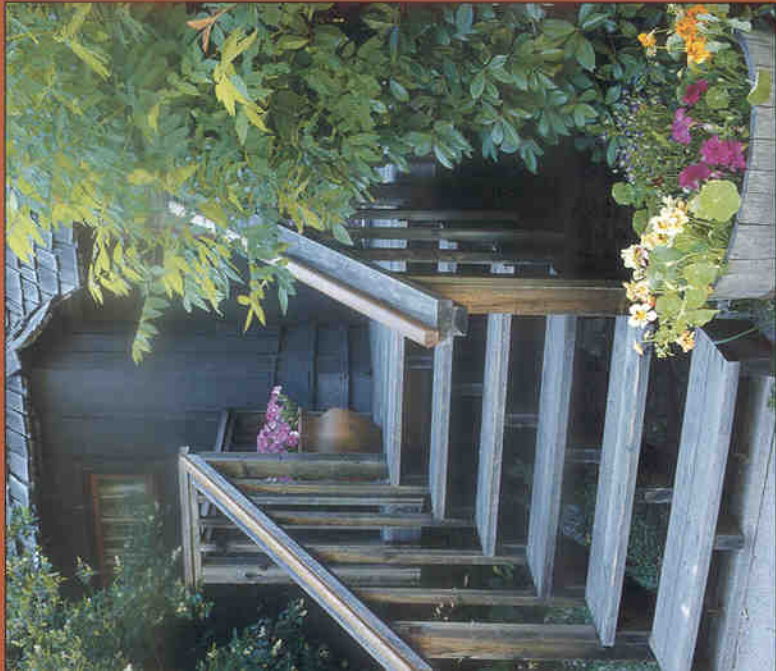
